**Dear Dance / Drill Team Director:**

“Six Flags” and “Miss Dance Drill Team USA” invite your Dance Team & Dance / Drill Team Squad to participate in the **28th Annual Six Flags Magic Mountain California Dance / Drill Team Competition**. The 2012 competition will be scheduled over two days. Elementary and Junior High teams will compete on Saturday, April 21st, 2012. The High School teams will compete on Sunday, April 22nd, 2012. This year’s event will once again be administered by “Miss Dance Drill Team USA ®”

The competition will consist of 4 Divisions and 8 Categories for Elementary, Junior High School and High School competitors. SMALL will be for teams with (5-12) members; MEDIUM will be for teams with (13-16) members; and LARGE will be for teams with (17+) members.

**Note: A maximum of 20 performers allowed on stage at one time.**

This competition is open to California Schools, Dance Studios, Parks & Recreation, and Independents.

**IMPORTANT** – Team Placement is based on the oldest age of the performer. Example: 7 Junior High competitors and 2 High School competitors – teams **MUST** compete in the High School division.

**ALL ROUTINES MUST INCLUDE FORMATION CHANGES AND SPECIFIC TECHNIQUE OF CATEGORY ENTERED.** For specific Performance / Category Guidelines, please see next page.

The California Dance / Drill Team Sweepstakes Championship Squad for Elementary, Junior High and High School Divisions will receive a cash donation to their school and a giant team trophy for each squad. Depending on the number of entries, separate trophies will also be awarded to top performing teams / squads within each division.

Competition will take place in the Golden Bear Theatre (approx. stage size = 31’ wide X 30’ deep). The competition will begin at 11:00 a.m. Any squad wishing to perform to music must bring a clearly labeled CD. Music and costume must be appropriate for your squad’s age group. Judging emphasis will include grooming and appearance, routine construction, execution, showmanship, and entertainment value. Performance time for teams will be limited to 3 minutes with a maximum of 20 dance / drill team members on stage at one time.

**Please be advised that the stage surface is wood with NO mats provided. All participants MUST wear shoes.**

A special discounted ticket rate of \$38.00 (Regular Gate Price: \$59.99) for competitors includes registration into the competition plus a full day of fun in Southern California’s most exciting family theme park. “Six Flags” will be open from 10:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 21st and 10:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 22nd. One complimentary ticket will be provided for every 15 tickets ordered. Competing teams ordering less than 15 tickets total will not be entitled to a complimentary advisor ticket.

**Season passes will not be accepted for competitor entry / admission.**

If season passes are being used for non-competitors/ spectators a \$5.00 wristband must be purchased to enter the Golden Bear Theater.

Entry fees for additional team entries is \$50 each entry.

Performers may not compete against themselves in the same division/category.

To be eligible, entries must be received By **Deadline: March 25th, 2012** with full payment. Late entries will owe a \$15.00 Late Fee. In addition, completed Medical Release forms for each competitor must be returned with entry form.

Any entry received without all completed Medical Release Forms and/or full payment will not be processed and will be returned immediately. The posted Medical Release Form is the only one that will be accepted. It cannot be altered. Medical Release Forms must be completed in ink with original signature. Final Instructions, additional information & Schedule will be e-mailed on or before April 16th to The School/Director's E-mail address listed on the Official Entry Form.

A special invitation is extended to Dance / Drill Team Squads who may not be interested in competing. Non-competitors and spectators can experience the fun and excitement for a special low price of just \$32.00 (Regular Gate Price: \$59.99). Use the Entry Form to order your discount tickets. Please make sure to check the box for Non-competing squads.

**Important Note:** Spectators and non-competitors who do not purchase the **"Miss Dance Drill Team USA"** Team Booster Tickets must purchase a \$5.00 wristband to enter the Golden Bear Theater.

**"Miss Dance Drill Team USA"** and **"Six Flags Magic Mountain"** are proud to host the **28th Annual California Dance / Drill Team Competition**. We hope your squad will join us for a rewarding and fun-filled day for all participants. Entries are limited, so don't miss out on all the fun!

### CATEGORY GUIDELINES

**All routines MUST include formation changes and specific technique of category entered.**

**\*\*NOTE\*\* There must be (5) entries in each Individual Category, otherwise Entry will go into "OPEN"**

**JAZZ** – Routine emphasis must be on dance, with creative freestyle movements. Props are permitted but must not be the major focal point of the routine.

**LYRICAL / MODERN** – Routine must be of a poetic style with soft, flowing choreography or creative dramatic movements. This is much more technical and controlled in nature than any other style of dance.

**HIP-HOP** – Routine emphasis must be on street dance, hip-hop, funk, free-style, popping, locking, and break dancing. Overall general effect must be on dance in nature. (All Female) – (All Male) – (Co-Ed)

**OPEN STYLE** – Any style and any category of dance.

**MILITARY** – Routine emphasis must be on precision moves with overall presentation being Military in nature, with defined straight-arm sequences and military transitions using various marching styles and pattern formations. Traditional Military style includes leading with the left foot. May incorporate "Kicking" sequence into routine.

**PROP / NOVELTY** – A Prop Routine's emphasis must be on the use of a prop or a variety of props. Overall general effect of the presentation must have the use of the props as the major focal point. A Novelty Routine's emphasis must be on characterization or be of a unique, thematic nature. Entrants must use clever costumes, make-up, and unusual or innovative moves extensively.

**POM / SONG** – Majority of routine (at least ¾ of routine) must be focused around the use of Pom Poms, using innovative dance and precision movements. Any size, shape, color of Pom Poms may be used.

# Dance / Drill Team Fact Sheet

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**Date:** Saturday, April 21st, 2012 (Elementary & Junior High)  
Sunday, April 22nd, 2012 (High School)

**Dressing Rooms:** There are NO dressing rooms available at Six Flags Magic Mountain. Your squad members should be dressed and ready to go upon arrival.  
Competitors **MUST** wear shoes and **MAY NOT** wear half sole shoes - **(Or competitors will be disqualified)**.  
Competitor's uniforms / costumes and music/lyrics must be appropriate for their grade level and in good taste **(Or a 2-point penalty will be assessed)**.

**Performing Area:** Golden Bear Theatre Stage – 31' wide X 30' deep, wood floor

**Music:** CD ONLY! Please label CD with school name. An advisor or representative **MUST** be present at the sound booth 15 minutes prior to your squad's performing time to help direct the sound technician **(Or a 2-point penalty will be assessed)**. Music must be turned in at the registration table when you arrive. Music must be a good quality CD. **(Or a 2-point penalty will be assessed)**. Inappropriate lyrics will receive a **(2-point penalty)**. Be sure to bring a back-up CD.

**Time Limit:** Maximum **3-minute** performance with a **2-point penalty assessed for overtime**.  
**Important Note:** 3.5 MINUTES OVERTIME AND BEYOND WILL BE **DISQUALIFIED**.

**Judging:** Emphasis will be on the most entertaining performances. The score sheet captions will include:

- Routine (40 points): Construction, Originality, Difficulty, Change of Pace, Etc.
- Execution (40 points): Unison, Technique, Timing, Carriage, Etc.
- Showmanship/Appearance (20 points): Presentation, Projection, Confidence, Audience Appeal, Grooming, Uniform, Etc.

**Other Penalties:** No pyramids over 2-high allowed **(Or a 2-point penalty will be assessed)**. No aerials, flips, or throws, etc. Contestants may do cartwheels, forward rolls or walkovers, with a maximum of 1 each or 3 total. **(Or a 2-point penalty will be assessed)**. Unacceptable dance movements not appropriate for your grade level will receive a **(2-point penalty)**. Any routine performed out of the scheduled order will receive a **(2-point penalty)**. Any change in category or performance order after the line-up has been published will receive a **(2-point penalty)** and must pay a \$15.00 Change Fee. A late fee of \$15.00 will be charged after deadline.

**Spectator Tickets:** Spectator / Non-Competitor tickets will be available for \$32.00 each with a minimum order of 10 tickets required. We recommend ten days advance payment to allow time for ticket fulfillment. This will eliminate unnecessary delays on competition day.

**Deadline:** Spectator / Non-Competitor ticket order should be received no later than April 13th, 2012 in order to allow for processing. Additional Spectator / Non-Competitor tickets will also be available at the pre-arranged group rate on the day of the event. All orders will be held for pick-up on competition day at the "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Ticket Will Call near the front gate of "Six Flags Magic Mountain".

**Eligibility:** Open to All Schools, Dance Studios, Parks & Recreation, & Independents. Limit 2 additional teams per School, Dance Studio, Park & Recreation, and Independents. Divisional breakdowns subject to change based on entries received. **NOTE: the performing area will only accommodate a maximum of 20 members**. Squads with over 20 members may rotate in additional members with no more than 20 members on stage at any one time.

**Additional Info:** **IMPORTANT** – Team Placement is based on the Oldest Age of the Performer Example: seven Junior High students and two High School students – team **MUST** compete in High School Division.
