GENERAL INFORMATION

"Miss" Solo Title: The "Miss Dance Drill Team California" Competition is composed of qualified and non-qualified Solo, Duet/Trio, Officer and Team divisions. The Miss Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" is a qualifying competition for the Nation's most lavish and colorful Dance & Pep Arts Pageant, "Miss Dance Drill Team USA!" The high point of the competition is the crowning of the "Miss" Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" selected after vigorous competition by contestants in the area of dance/drill routine, modeling, preliminary interview and/or impromptu question. Each school may enter up to (3) Contestants. The top (10) "Solo Title" winners move on to compete in the "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Pageant on March 22nd, 23rd & 24th, 2012, at the "Hyatt Regency" Hotel and Bren Events Center in Irvine, Ca. State pageants are held as preliminary competitions for the Miss Dance Drill Team USA "Solo Title". States that hold Official "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Pageants may enter any or all of their "Solo Title" finalists (up to 10) in the National Competition. "Miss Teen" Solo Title: "Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" Pageant is chartered by the "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Pageant. The "Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" is a qualifying competition for "Miss Dance Drill Team USA!" The high point of the competition is the crowning of the "Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" selected after vigorous competition by contestants in the area of dance/drill routine, modeling, preliminary interview and/or impromptu question. Each school may enter up to (3) Contestants. The top (10) "Miss Teen" Solo Title winners move on to compete in the "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Pageant on March 22nd, 23rd & 24th, 2012. State pageants are held as preliminary competitions for the "Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team USA "Solo Title". States that hold Official "Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team USA Pageants may enter any or all of their "Miss Teen" finalists (up to 10) in the National Competition.

ELIGIBILITY: Contestant must be a single girl, U.S. citizen, registered student at the high school she is representing, and be an active member of the school dance/drill team, (or comparable school program). She should be of good character, possess poise, personality, intelligence, be in excellent health and be an outstanding citizen in her school and community. **A Contestant's Age on January 27th, 2012:** "Miss" Solo shall not be less than 16 years or more than 19 years old – "Miss Teen" Solo shall not be less than 13 years or more than 15 years old. The contestant, parents/guardian, and the school Dance Drill Team Director or Principal must sign the official Miss Dance Drill Team California Application. Bring Birth certificate to the Pageant for verification.

ENTRANCE FEE:

"Miss" Dance Drill Team California Solo Title contestant fee is **\$135.00** (non-refundable).

This amount includes entry fee, a program, a ticket to all performances, luncheon & hotel room.

"Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team California Solo Title contestant fee is **\$100.00** (non-refundable). This amount includes entry fee, a program, a ticket to all performances & luncheon.

Make check payable to "MDDTUSA" and Mail with Application.

DEADLINE: All applications must be postmarked on or before December 21st, 2011. Entries mailed after this date Must Include a **\$30.00** late fee.

MUSIC / CD: All music must be recorded on a new, high quality CD with only ONE SONG on each CD – (Back-up CD required). Your performance music label must be on the CD and marked as follows: a) school, b) division, c) title of music selection. When burning own Music on CD, you MUST Use CD-R (NOT CD-RW) and "Close the Disc".

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS: Props/Sets may be used in a routine. All props/sets must be rubber-tipped to prevent floor damage. If protective tips are not used, you will be disqualified. Any damage to facilities/floor will result in disqualification and charged to Contestant's school.

COSTUMES/UNIFORMS: Your Performance Costume must enhance the theme and/or style of the routine. The costume must be in good taste, appropriate for a high school girl, and approved by the Director. Only soft or rubber-soled shoes are permitted on the floor or Contestant will be disqualified. Our preference is that Contestants wear soft/rubber sole shoes; however, half-soles/bare feet will be permitted. A 5-point penalty is assessed for inappropriate costume, or disqualification.

PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE: Performance Schedule and Final Instructions will be E-mailed to the Director on or before January 15th, 2012. Schedule conflicts must be approved prior to January 18th, 2012. (No changes to the schedule after this date)

****MANDATORY RULE:** 5-point penalty will be assessed to a Contestant who does not compete at assigned time on competition day. **Not applicable if assigned time is changed by Pageant Staff.

REGISTRATION: A **Mandatory** Luncheon and Orientation will be held on Friday, January 27th, 2012 at the "Hyatt Regency" Hotel (Irvine, CA) for All "Solo Title" Contestants.

IMPORTANT: ("Miss" Solo Title Contestants Only) Contestants staying in the reserved "Miss" rooms, at the Hotel, may check into their rooms on Friday, January 27th, after 3:00 p.m. (4) Contestants per room. A Contestant not staying in a reserved "Miss" room on Friday, January 27th, must have her Director contact the "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Office by December 21st, 2011 or attach a note to the application. **Changes in room arrangements, after December 21st, 2011, will result in a 5-point penalty being assessed and an extra charge to the contestant for cost of hotel room and tax. No Exceptions!

QUALIFICATIONS/JUDGING

ROUTINES: Contestant must possess and display talent in a routine of not less than (90 seconds), and not more than (2 minutes). This talent may be in any or all phases of dance/drill team. Timing of the routine starts with the first beat of music and ends with the last beat of music. A 2-point penalty is assessed for being under or over time. Judging of the routine will be approximately 70% of the total scoring. Contestant will be judged on routine, appearance, execution and showmanship. Contestants are limited to (3) gymnastic feats. Suggestive movements, deemed in poor taste, will result in a 5-point penalty, or disqualification. Can't compete same routine in multiple categories.

MODELING: Contestant must perform a compulsory format. Judging will be on modeling (5) dance/drill team positions for starting or ending a routine. Total timing must not exceed 45 seconds. All contestants are to wear plain, black, long-sleeved leotards (no sheer, low cut or trim on leotards), black tights (no net or lace) and appropriate soft or rubber-soled shoes. All of the above are mandatory. No music or accompaniment is played during preliminaries. Modeling floor will be approximately 30' X 30' and may be carpeted. Judging will be approximately 15% of the total scoring for modeling. A contestant is scored on appearance, presentation of content and execution of the following modeling positions:

Position #1-POSE (pause), then WALK 8 Steps to Position #2-POSE (pause), then WALK 8 Steps to Position #3-POSE (pause), and so on. After the 5th Position - POSE (pause), and then Exit. Walking Only is permitted, (no strutting, jazz walks, runs, marching or dancing) from position to position. A 2-point penalty is assessed for: 1) Overtime, 2) Leotard, Tights or Shoe infractions, or 3) non-compliance to compulsory modeling format. Modeling will be part of the Final competition on Saturday.

PRELIMINARY INTERVIEW: Contestant will be scored on a short interview during the preliminary part of the competition (not to exceed 45 seconds). Scoring is based on confidence, projection, poise, diction and enthusiasm. Judging will be approximately 15% of the total scoring for interview. Contestant must wear their modeling leotard with a plain, black dance skirt and appropriate shoes during the preliminary interview. No notes or props!

IMPROMPTU QUESTION: The top (5) "Miss" Solo Title finalists will be asked an impromptu question during the finals. The finalists must wear a formal or long dress during this phase of the evening Pageant. Scoring will be based on response, confidence, projection, poise, diction and enthusiasm. Judging will be approximately 15% of the total scoring for the question.

Note: "Miss Teen" Solo Title Modeling & Interview scores will be carried over from Prelims

PRELIMINARIES: Preliminary Modeling, Interview & Routine for "Miss" & "Miss Teen" Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" competition will be held on Friday, January 27th, 2012 at the "Hyatt Regency" Irvine. Immediately Following Orientation and Lunch.

FINALS / AWARDS: The Pageant Finals are on Saturday, January 28th, at the "Hyatt Regency" Hotel. All "Solo Title" Contestants will be introduced during the Pageant.

****Miss Teen" Solo Title:** Top 10 finalists will be announced. These 10 finalists will compete in the **Routine Category Only** (Modeling & Interview scores will be carried over from Prelims). The Miss "Teen" Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" winner and her court will be announced. All "Ten" finalists are eligible to compete at the 45th Annual "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Pageant.

****Miss" Solo Title:** Top (10-15) finalists will be announced. These (10-15) finalists will compete in the routine category only. Top (8-10) finalists will present modeling poses and Top (5) finalists will be asked an impromptu question. The Miss Dance Drill Team California "Solo Title" winner and her court will be announced. All "Ten" finalists are eligible to compete at the 45th Annual "Miss Dance Drill Team USA" Pageant.

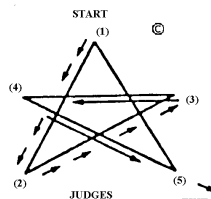

REGARDING CATEGORIES: There must be (5) entries in each Individual Category; otherwise Entry will go into “OPEN”

TIME SPECIFICS:

For: **Solos and Duet/Trios**, Contestants must possess and display talent in a Routine of not Less than 90 seconds and not more than 2 minutes.
For: **Officers**, Contestants must possess and display talent in a Routine of not more than 3 minutes.
For: **Teams**, Contestants must possess and display talent in a Routine of not Less than 2 minutes and not more than 3 minutes.

SCORING:

Scoring will be on technique, appearance, routine content, execution, and showmanship.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Additional Awards will be presented on a ratio of one for every five entries in a category. High Point winners will perform in the evening pageant. “Special Awards” for Choreography, Technique, Showmanship, Sweepstakes and More!!!

Note: “Best of California” Solo Division, Duets/Trios and Officers Award Presentation will be held at the “Hyatt Regency” Irvine on Friday, January 27th, 2012 ~ immediately following Competition!

DIVISIONS/QUALIFICATIONS:

Large categories may be sub-divided according to the number of Contestants. Pageant Directors reserve the right to make Category/Division/Size changes. In order to gain maximum number of points, be sure you have entered the correct category. A **5 – point penalty** is assessed for Contestants entered in the wrong category and will be subject to disqualification pending the decision of the Judges.

PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE:

A school or independent team may enter a team in several categories. An individual may represent her/his school in as many divisions and categories as she/he chooses, however, Contestants may encounter conflicts in the Performance Schedule. Performance Schedule and Final Instructions will be E-mailed to the Director’s address indicated on the Application Form on or before **January 15th, 2012**. Schedule conflicts must be resolved prior to January 18th. Due to the size of the Competition, adjustments **cannot** be made for the convenience of the Contestants who have entered 2 or more categories. A **5 – point penalty** will be assessed to Contestants who do not compete at assigned time on competition day (not applicable if assigned time changed by Pageant Staff member.) Contestants will compete in an assigned order at a designated time. Register as soon as you arrive on site, at least one hour before your scheduled performance time.

CATEGORY GUIDELINES:

Jazz – Routine emphasis must be on dance, less defined in presentation than Lyrical/Modern, with creative freestyle movements, with emphasis on showmanship. Props are permitted but must not be the major focal point of the routine.

Hip Hop – Routine emphasis must be on street dance, hip hop, funk, free style, popping, locking and break dancing. May include up to 3 gymnastic feats. Overall general effect must be dance in nature.

Lyrical/Modern – Routine must be of a poetic style with soft, flowing choreography and may include creative/dramatic movements. It is much more technical and controlled in nature than any other style of dance.

Kick – Majority of routine must be emphasized by defined and precise kicks and kick lines, with a focus on height and unison. Must also incorporate level changes and varied formations. Focal point must be “Kick.”

Pom – Majority of routine (at least ¾ of routine) must be focused around the use of Pom Pons, using innovative dance and precision movements. Any size/shape/color of Pom Pons may be used.

Military – Routine emphasis must be on precision moves, marching, and maneuvering formations. Overall general effect of presentation must be Military in nature with defined, straight-arm work.

Prop/Novelty – A Prop Routine’s emphasis must be on the use of a prop or a variety of props. Overall general effect of the presentation must have the use of props as the major focal point. A Novelty Routine’s emphasis must be on characterization or be of a unique, thematic nature. Entrants must use clever costumes, make-up and unusual or innovative moves

Open Style – Any Style and any category of dance or precision. Military movements may be used in the routine.

IMPORTANT NOTES: All Solos, Duets/Trios, and Officer will compete on Friday, January 27th, at the host hotel starting at 3:00 P.M. (Depending on Scheduling “Mini” Teams may also compete on Friday)

SOLOIST: Solo’s are limited to entering maximum of (2) solo categories.

Note: “Miss” & “Miss Teen” Dance Drill Team California Solo Title Contestants **ARE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THIS CATEGORY.**

INAPPROPRIATE: If dance movements, music lyrics, or costuming are deemed to be too suggestive or otherwise inappropriate for our family audience, they will be scored lower by the judges.

DAMAGES: PROPS or SETS that are used in your routine must be **RUBBER-TIPPED** in order to prevent scratching the floors. A **5 – point penalty** will be assessed for failing to use protective tips and may result in disqualification. You will need a 2” ramp to roll sets on floors. Any damages to facilities, including floors, will be charged to the school or organization and will result in disqualification.

FOOTWEAR: Our preference is that Contestants wear soft/rubber sole shoes; however, half-soles/bare feet will be permitted. **NOTE: Only soft/rubber sole shoes are permitted on the floor. Any Damages to Floors will result in Disqualification.**

MUSIC: CD’S: All music must be recorded on a new, **high quality CD** with only **ONE SONG** on each CD – (**Back-up CD required**). Your performance music label must be on the CD and marked as follows: a) school, b) division, c) title of music selection. When burning own Music on CD, you **MUST Use CD-R (NOT CD-RW)**
